Normal check-in time is 3pm, if this does not suit you or you would prefer to check-in at another time. I may be able to arrange this, please just text or WhatsApp me before check-in. You are always welcome to drop your bags off at one of the properties if you are arriving early

Check-out is at 11am, but again, let me know in advance if you'd like to check-in at a different time and we'll try to work something out.

All towels and linens are provided, as well as hairdryer and iron.

Getting to/from the airport:

A Cab from the airport should cost approximately €30. The journey time is around 30 mins.

Otherwise the 757 bus, leaving the airport every 30 minutes costs €7 per person and will take you to the 'Steven's Green' stop, from where it is a 3 minute walk to the Townhouse, more info here:

## Bedroom layout:

ground floor - 1 x double bedroom This room is often used by guests who would like to avoid using stairs.

first floor - 2 x double bedrooms 1 x bunk bedroom 1 x family bedroom with 1 double bed and stairs to loft room with 2 single beds

All the double and single beds are standard UK/Ireland sizes (54inch × 75inch and 35inch × 75inch).
